Anthropology majors must complete one of the following sequences of courses:

Sequence A

A minor approved by the student's advisor or 18+

Sequence B

Design an array of supporting coursework to complement your course of study in Anthropology approved by the student's advisor. 18

Departmental Honors: Students may graduate with Departmental Honors if they meet the following requirements: GPA of 3.5 or higher and complete an undergraduate thesis in Anthropology

The maximum number of Anthropology **transfer credits** accepted is 18.

Major requirements include 21 elective Anthropology credits, of which 18 must be upper division (300 level and above) and one course can be lower division (200 level).

The total ANTY **curriculum requirements** are 39 credits, 12 additional major credit requirements include SOCI, STAT, PHL & HSTR courses, and 18+ credits are required within a declared minor or specific track for a combined total of 69 credits within ANTY major requirements (69cr major + 30cr CORE + 21cr electives =120cr).

No more than 6 credits of ANTY 490R or ANTY 492 combined can count toward fulfillment of the elective credits.

For **graduation** in Anthropology students must have a grade of **C- or higher in all Anthropology courses**. A minimum of 120 credits is required for graduation; 42 of these credits must be in courses numbered 300 and above.
